**CONSENT ORDER**

This matter coming on for hearing before the Commission at Brisbane on 27 July 2017, the Commission orders that the said Award be varied, by consent, as follows as from 27 July 2017:

1. By inserting a new definition into clause 3, in alphabetical order, as follows:

**QRIC** means the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission, established in accordance with the *Racing Integrity Act 2016*.

2. By inserting a new clause 12.16, as follows:

**12.16 Performance of higher duties – QRIC**

If, during a race meeting, a QRIC employee is required to perform all, or a substantial part of, the duties of a Starter, Judge, Assistant Judge or Steward, they will be entitled to receive, as a minimum, the relevant payment applicable to the Starter, Judge, Assistant Judge or Steward role performed, subject to certification by the employee’s supervisor.

3. By deleting clause 13.1 (Adverse conditions allowance) and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

All employees engaged by Agriculture within the Forestry Stream, and QRIC employees, working in the open and thereby being subject to adverse conditions such as working in isolated and undeveloped locations, exposure to heat, cold, wind, wetness, dust, mud, dirty conditions, and lack of amenities are to be paid an allowance at the rate of \$30.20 per week which will be treated as part of the ordinary weekly wage for the purpose of this Award.

4. By inserting a new clause 13.10(i), as follows:

- (i) (i) An employee engaged by QRIC to perform work at a race meeting will be paid a meal allowance of \$12.85. If the employee is required to be at a race meeting spanning two meal periods, two meal allowances of \$12.85 will be paid.
- (ii) The payment of the meal allowances is in lieu of QRIC being able to provide a structured meal break during the course of the employee’s duties.

5. By deleting clause 13.11 (Risk allowance) and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

An employee of Agriculture employed at a regional experimental station, research station or animal health station, and a QRIC employee, who is required to handle materials or animals infected with disease pathogenic to humans shall be paid an extra \$21.50 per fortnight.

6. By inserting a new provision in the table at clause 15.1(a) (Ordinary hours of duty), as follows:

7. By inserting a new provision in the table at Clause 15.3(a) (Spread of ordinary hours of duty – day workers), as follows:
