### Reasons for Decision

- [1] This application was made by Mr Neil Singleton, the Insurance Commissioner, of the National Injury Insurance Agency (Queensland). The application, made pursuant to section 147 of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld), seeks to vary the *Queensland*

*Public Service Officers and Other Employees Award – State 2015* to cover employees of the National Injury Insurance Agency (Queensland).

- [2] The proposed variations are agreed between the relevant parties, namely, the National Injury Insurance Agency (Queensland), and Together Queensland, Industrial Union of Employees.
- [3] On the basis that there is consent between the relevant parties to vary the Award the Commission issues the following Orders:
1. **the *Queensland Public Service Officers and Other Employees Award – State 2015* be varied in the terms set out in the attached Order; and**
  2. **the variations to the Award operate on and from 15 January 2018.**
