End note: A prime contractor should be aware of the contents of the whole of chapter 9, part 2, division 2 of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016*, –

In particular section 361(4) states -

After being served with a notice, the prime contractor may pay the amount to which the notice relates to a clerk of the Magistrates Court until –

- (a) an industrial magistrate makes an order in relation to the amount; or
- (b) the notice is withdrawn.
