## **Reasons for Decision**

- [1] The Paroo Shire Council has applied to terminate the *Paroo Shire Council Inside Staff Certified Agreement 2009*, it does so pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 2016. The certified agreement had a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2012.
- [2] On the basis that the agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need to be met before it may be terminated; that the Commission is satisfied that the Paroo Shire Counil has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the agreement; that the other parties to the agreement agree to it being terminated; and, that the termination of the determination is not contrary to the public interest; the *Paroo Shire Council Inside Staff Certified Agreement 2009*, is terminated as from 19 November 2018.
- [3] I make the following order:
  - 1. The Paroo Shire Council Inside Staff Certified Agreement 2009 is terminated.
