Reasons for Decision

- On 23 October 2019, Queensland Fire and Emergency Services applied, pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* ('the Act'), to terminate the *Queensland Fire and Emergency Service Certified Agreement 2016* ('the certified agreement').
- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2019.
- On the basis that the agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need to be met before it may be terminated; that the Commission is satisfied that the State of Queensland (Queensland Fire and Emergency Services) has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the agreement; that the other parties to the agreement agree to it being terminated; and, that the termination of the agreement is not contrary to the public interest; the *Queensland Fire and Emergency Service Certified Agreement 2016* is terminated as and from 6 November 2019.
