## **Reasons for Decision**

- [1] The State of Queensland (Queensland Police Service) has applied to terminate the *Queensland Police Service Certified Agreement 2016* pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 2016.
- [2] The certified agreement had a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2019.
- [3] On the basis that the agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need to be met before it may be terminated; that the Commission is satisfied that the Queensland Police Service has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the agreement; that the other parties to the agreement agree to it being terminated; and, that the termination of the agreement is not contrary to the public interest; the *Queensland Police Service Certified Agreement 2016* is terminated as from 15 November 2019.
- [4] I make the following order:
  - 1. The Queensland Police Service Certified Agreement 2016 is terminated.
