Reasons for Decision

- [1] On 2 December 2019, the Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council applied, pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* ('the Act'), to terminate the *NPARC Certified Agreement*, 2012-2014 ('the certified agreement').
- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2014.
- [3] Section 228(3) of the Act provides:
 - (3) The commission must approve the termination if, and must refuse to approve the termination unless, satisfied subsection (2) has been complied with and -
 - (a) for an agreement or determination that provides that it may be terminated if particular conditions are met - the conditions have been met; or
 - (b) for an agreement or determination that does not provide for the way it may be terminated -
 - (i) the other parties to the agreement or determination agree to it being terminated; and
 - (ii) termination of the agreement or determination is not contrary to the public interest.
- [4] I have had regard to:
 - the submissions made by the parties who appeared today; and
 - the affidavit of Mr Graeme Gillam, Chief Executive Officer of the Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council, filed on 2 December 2019.
- [5] The certified agreement does not provide that particular conditions need to be met before it may be terminated.
- [6] I am satisfied that the Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council has given the requisite notice of its intention to apply to terminate the certified agreement.
- [7] On 2 December 2019, the Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council made an application, pursuant to s 189 of the Act, to certify the *Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council Certified Agreement 2019*.
- [8] The Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council and the following employee organisations have agreed to the terms of the *Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council Certified Agreement 2019* which will replace the certified agreement:
 - The Australian Workers' Union of Employees, Queensland; and
 - Queensland Services, Industrial Union of Employees.
- [9] I am satisfied that:
 - all parties to the certified agreement agree to it being terminated; and

- the termination of the certified agreement is not contrary to the public interest.
- [10] Section 228(4) of the Act provides that termination takes effect when the Commission's approval takes effect.
- [11] I approve the termination of the *NPARC Certified Agreement*, 2012-2014 with effect from 20 December 2019.
- [12] I make the following order:

The NPARC Certified Agreement, 2012-2014 is terminated.
