Reasons for Decision

- [1] The South Burnett Regional Council has applied to terminate the *South Burnett Regional Council Certified Agreement - Officers 2011.* It does so pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 2016.
- [2] The Agreement nominally expired on 15 March 2014 and the parties consent to its termination.
- [3] On the basis that the agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particularly conditions need to be met before it may be terminated;¹ that the Commission is satisfied that the South Burnett Regional Council has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the agreement;² that the other parties to the agreement agree to it being terminated;³ and, that the termination of the agreement is not contrary to the public interest;⁴ the *South Burnett Regional Council Certified Agreement Officers 2011* is terminated as from 6 July 2020.⁵
- [4] I make the following order: **The** *South Burnett Regional Council Certified Agreement Officers* 2011 is terminated.
