7. If leave is granted by the Commission, an outline of submissions (only) is to be filed in the Industrial Registry AND served on the Applicant by no later than **4.00pm on Thursday, 10 September 2020.**
8. This matter will be heard before Industrial Commissioner Hartigan at the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission, 66 Eagle Street (Corner of Elizabeth and Creek Streets), Brisbane on **Friday, 11 September 2020 at 2.15pm.**
