At present, Aurizon provides workers operating its locomotive fleet, located at the Pring Depot, access to camp toilets in the cabs of the locomotives whilst these workers are driving their trains. 2. These camp toilets have not been manufactured for commercial use and therefore prone to issues surrounding their ability to cope in a commercial setting. 3. In the past 12 months two drivers have reported that they have been injured removing the effluent containers whilst cleaning the camp toilets. This has included at least one matter requiring medical assistance. 4. The RBTU has identified issues pertaining to musculoskeletal, hygiene and other uncontrolled risks being experienced by workers when undertaking tasks pertaining to the cleaning and use of these toilets.
