Reasons for Decision

- [1] On 5 August 2022, the Burke Shire Council ('the Council') applied, pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) ('the Act'), to terminate the *Burke Shire Council Certified Agreement 2017* ('the certified agreement').
- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 29 January 2022.
- [3] The application was filed in the Industrial Registry together with affidavits in support of Mr Daniel McKinlay, Chief Executive Officer of the Council, and a Notice of Intention to terminate a Certified Agreement.
- [4] Having regard to the material relied upon in support of the application, I am satisfied that:
 - the certified agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need be met before it may be terminated;¹
 - the Council has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the certified agreement;²
 - all parties to the certified agreement agree to it being terminated;³ and
 - the termination of the certified agreement is not contrary to the public interest.⁴
- [5] Section 228(4) of the Act provides that termination takes effect when the Commission's approval takes effect.
- [6] In this matter, an application was made to certify the *Burke Shire Council Certified* Agreement 2022.⁵
- [7] Accordingly, I approve the termination of the certified agreement with effect from 29 August 2022.
- [8] I make the following order:
 - 1. The Burke Shire Council Certified Agreement 2017 is terminated.
