



1. I am the General Secretary of the Queensland Council of Unions.
2. The application that this affidavit accompanies seeks a general ruling pursuant to Section 458 of the Industrial Relations Act 2016.
3. The quantum sought in the application replicates the quantum declared by the Fair Work Commission in the Annual Wage Review 2021-22 on 15 June 2022.
4. The general ruling seeks to increase wages or salaries for full time adult employees in all state awards by \$40 per week or 4.6 per cent, whichever is the higher from 1 September 2022.
5. The general ruling seeks to increase monetary allowances (other than expense related allowances) that relate to work or conditions which have not changed, and to service increments in all state awards by 4.6 per cent.
6. The general ruling also seeks to increase the Queensland minimum wage by 5.2 per cent.
7. The application seeks an operative date of 1 September 2022 in line with the previous practices of the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission.






