## **Reasons for Decision**

- On 3 February 2022, the Quilpie Shire Council ('the Council'), applied, pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) ('the IR Act'), to terminate the *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2018* ('the certified agreement').
- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2021.
- [3] The application was filed in the Industrial Registry, together with an affidavit in support of Mr Justin Hancock, Chief Executive Officer of the Council, and a Notice of Intention to terminate a Certified Agreement.
- [4] Having regard to the material relied upon in support of the application, I am satisfied that:
  - (a) the certified agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need be met before it may be terminated;<sup>1</sup>
  - (b) the Council has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the certified agreement;<sup>2</sup>
  - (c) all parties to the certified agreement agree to it being terminated;<sup>3</sup> and
  - (d) the termination of the certified agreement is not contrary to the public interest.<sup>4</sup>

- [5] I have also had regard to an application having been made by the Council, the Construction, Forestry, Mining & Energy, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland, the Queensland Services, Industrial Union of Employees and The Australian Workers Union of Employees, Queensland to certify the *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2021*. 5
- [6] Section 228(4) of the IR Act provides that termination takes effect when the Commission's approval takes effect, accordingly, I approve the termination of the certified agreement with effect from 22 February 2022.
- [7] I make the following order:

The Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2018 is terminated.
