## **Reasons for Decision**

- [1] On 3 February 2022, the Quilpie Shire Council ('the Council') filed an application pursuant to s 189 of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) ('the IR Act') to certify the *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2021* ('the agreement').
- [2] The named parties to the agreement are the Council and the following employee organisations:
  - (a) the Construction, Forestry, Mining & Energy, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland;
  - (b) the Queensland Services, Industrial Union of Employees; and
  - (c) The Australian Workers' Union of Employees, Queensland
- [3] As required by s 189(3) of the IR Act, the application was made within 21 days of the date on which the agreement was signed by all the above-mentioned parties.
- [4] The agreement applies to the Council and all Council employees, except for employees that are employed under the classification of 'Senior Officer' as defined in the *Queensland Local Government Industry (Stream A) Award State 2017.*<sup>1</sup>
- [5] Having regard to the submissions made by the parties who appeared at the hearing of the matter on 22 February 2022, and the material filed,<sup>2</sup> I am satisfied that:

- (a) each relevant requirement under Ch 4, Pt 5, Sub-Div.2 of the IR Act have been satisfied; and
- (b) there is nothing in the agreement which would require the Commission to refuse to grant the application under Ch 4, Pt 5, Sub-Div.3 of the IR Act.
- [6] Accordingly, the application to certify the *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement* 2021 is granted.
- [7] The *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2021* operates from the date it was certified, namely 22 February 2022.
- [8] Although the nominal expiry date of the *Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2021* is 22 February 2025, the agreement will continue to operate until it is terminated under ss 227 or 228 of the IR Act.
- [9] I make the following order:

The Quilpie Shire Council Certified Agreement 2021 is certified.
