Reasons for Decision

On 31 March 2025, City Parkland Services Pty Ltd ('the Applicant') made an application to certify the *City Parklands Certified Agreement 2024* ('the Agreement') pursuant to section 189 of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) ('the IR Act').

- [2] The named parties to the Agreement are the Applicant and the following employee organisations:
 - (a) Construction, Forestry, Mining & Energy, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland;
 - (b) Plumbers & Gasfitters Employees' Union Queensland, Union of Employees;
 - (c) Queensland Services, Industrial Union of Employees;
 - (d) The Australian Workers' Union of Employees, Queensland;
 - (e) The Electrical Trades Union of Employees Queensland; and
 - (f) United Workers' Union, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland.
- The Agreement is signed by all the named parties to the Agreement. The Agreement shall apply to all of the Applicant's employees covered by the *City Parklands Services Award State 2016* and the employee organisations mentioned above.
- [4] Having regard to the submissions made by the parties who appeared at the hearing of the application, to the correspondence received from the excused union parties in support of the application,¹ and to the affidavit of Mr Sean Madigan, the Chief Executive Officer of the Applicant, filed on 31 March 2025:
 - (a) I am satisfied that each relevant requirement in ch 4, pt 5, div 2, sub-div 2 of the IR Act has been met; and
 - (b) there is nothing in the Agreement which would require me to refuse to grant the application pursuant to ch 4, pt 5, div 2, sub-div 3 of the IR Act.
- [5] The application to certify the Agreement is granted.
- [6] The Agreement operates from the day it is certified, namely, 7 May 2025.
- [7] Although the nominal expiry date of the Agreement is 30 June 2027, the Agreement continues to operate until it is terminated pursuant to s 227 or s 228 of the IR Act.
