- 7. Each party shall be at liberty to file in the Industrial Registry, and serve on each other party, any further submissions in reply **by 4.00pm on 15 August 2025**.

That the matter be heard before a Full Bench comprised of President Davis, Vice President O'Connor and Deputy President Hartigan at the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission, Level 22, Central Plaza 2, 66 Eagle Street (Corner Elizabeth and Creek Streets), Brisbane, at <u>10.00am on 19 August 2025.</u>
- 9. The parties have liberty to apply on two days' notice to the other parties for a further mention before the Vice President.
