Reasons for Decision

- [1] On 9 May 2025, the Ipswich City Council (Council) ('the Applicant') applied, pursuant to s 189 of the *Industrial Relations Act* 2016 ('the Act'), to certify the *Ipswich City Council Local Government Employees Certified Agreement 2024* ('the agreement').
- [2] The named organisations to the agreement are the applicant and the following employee organisations:
 - The Electrical Trades Union of Employees Queensland
 - The Australian Workers' Union of Employees, Queensland
 - Automotive, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland
 - Construction, Forestry, Mining & Energy, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland

- Plumbers & Gasfitters Employees' Union Queensland, Union of Employees
- Transport Workers' Union of Australia, Union of Employees
- [3] The agreement has the approval of all the above-mentioned parties.
- [4] The agreement applies to the employees covered by the classifications contained in the agreement as prescribed in *Queensland Local Government Industry (Stream B) Award State 2017* and *Queensland Local Government Industry (Stream C) Award State 2017*
- [5] Having regard to the submissions made by the parties who appeared today and to the affidavit of Sonia Cooper, Chief Executive Officer of the Applicant filed on 9 May 2025
 - I am satisfied of each relevant requirement in ch4, pt5 div 2, sub-div 2 of the Act; and
 - There is nothing in the agreement which would require me to refuse to grant the application pursuant to ch4, pt 5, di 2, sub-div 3 of the Act.
- [6] The application to certify the *Ipswich City Council Local Government Employees*Certified Agreement 2024 is granted
- [7] The *Ipswich City Council Local Government Employees Certified Agreement* 2024 operates from the day it is certified, namely 2 June 2025.
- [8] Although the nominal expiry date of the *Ipswich City Council Local Government Employees Certified Agreement* 2024 is 1 July 2027, it continues to operate until it is terminated under s 227 or s 228 of the Act.
- [9] I make the following order:

The Ipswich City Council Local Government Employees Certified Agreement 2024 is certified.
