

Extract of Definitions of Trading Areas as at 29 June 2026

The below information regarding the definitions of the trading areas has been extracted from the [Trading \(Allowable Hours\) Act 1990](#), the [2017 Trading Hours Order \[Repealed\]](#)¹ and the [Trading Hours - Non-exempt shops Selling Motor Vehicles - State \("Car Yards Order"\) \[Repealed\]](#)² and is provided for information purposes only.

To the extent the area is the subject of a trading area order that is inconsistent with the *2017 Trading Hours Order*, the trading area order prevails and the reference to the area must, to the extent the context permits, be interpreted consistently with the trading area order.³

Area of New Farm of Inner City of Brisbane

That area as bound by the Brisbane River to the East, South and West, and to the North by a line connecting the River to Harcourt Street to Chester Street to Ann Street to Breakfast Creek Road to Waterloo Street and following a line North-East from Waterloo Street to the River.

Gold Coast Coastal Tourist Area

Commencing at Sea World Drive, The Spit; from there in line due east to the sea coast; then following the sea coast in a south-easterly direction to the Queensland/New South Wales border; from there following Boundary Street in a south-westerly direction until its intersection with Griffith Street; from there following Griffith Street in a westerly direction until its intersection with Lanham Street; from there following Lanham Street and Gordon Lane in a south-westerly direction until Gordon Lane's intersection with Tweed Street, from there following Tweed Street in a westerly direction until its intersection with Coolangatta Road; from there following Coolangatta Road in a north-westerly direction until its intersection with the Gold Coast Highway; from there following the Gold Coast Highway in a north-westerly direction until its intersection with Tweed Street; from there following Tweed Street in a northerly direction until its intersection with the Gold Coast Highway; from there following the Gold Coast Highway in a north-westerly direction until its intersection with Remembrance Drive; from there following Remembrance Drive in a northerly direction until its intersection with Ferny Avenue; from there following Ferny Avenue in a northerly direction until its intersection with the Gold Coast Highway; from there following the Gold Coast Highway in a northerly direction until its intersection with Waterways Drive; from there in a north-easterly direction until its intersection with Macarthur Parade; from there in a north-easterly direction until its intersection at Sea World Drive, The Spit, and to include the Australia Fair Shopping precinct situated at 42 Marine Parade, Southport:

Provided that non-exempt shops located on either side of any of the roads mentioned herein shall be deemed to be included within the definition of the Gold Coast Coastal Tourist Area.

Hamilton North Shore Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of Kingsford Smith Drive and Riverview Terrace; then along Kingsford Smith Drive to the intersection with the Southern Cross Way; then along the Southern Cross Way to where it joins with the Gateway Motorway; then along the Gateway Motorway to the Brisbane River, then along the Brisbane River to the point of commencement.

Provided that where the boundary is comprised of a street, road or highway, shops on both sides of the street, road or highway shall be regarded as being within the area.

Mossman and Port Douglas Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Captain Cook Highway and Port Douglas Road; from there in a line due east to the sea coast; from there following the sea coast in a northerly direction to Cooya Beach; then in a line from the seacoast to the junction of Palm Street and Bougainvillea street; then following a straight line in a westerly direction to its intersection with the Mossman Daintree Road; then following the Mossman Daintree Road in a southerly direction until its join with the Captain Cook Highway; then following the Captain Cook Highway in a southerly direction to the point of commencement:

Provided that non-exempt shops located on either side of any roads mentioned herein shall be deemed to be included within the definition of the Mossman and Port Douglas Tourist Area.

South-East Queensland Area

- (a) the Sunshine Coast Area;
- (b) the area east of the Bruce Highway between the existing Sunshine Coast Area and the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (c) the area occupied by non-exempt shops fronting onto the western side of the Bruce Highway between the existing Sunshine Coast Area and the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (d) the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (e) the local government area for the Gold Coast City Council that is not included in the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (f) the islands in the coastal waters of the State east of the areas mentioned in (a) to (e) that are not included in the Brisbane Statistical Division.
- (g) the area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where the Bruce Highway intersects with Bells Creek Road; from that point following a line due west until the line intersects with Old Gympie Road; from that point following a direct line to the point where the Bruce Highway intersects with Red Road; from that point in a northerly direction along the Bruce Highway to the point of commencement.
- (h) the town of Beaudesert being the area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of Waters Creek and the Mount Lindesay Highway; then along Waters Creek in a westerly direction until its junction with the Logan River; then along a line due south to its intersection with Thiedeke Road; then in a straight line to the junction of the Beaudesert-Nerang Road and Brooklands Street; and then in a straight line to the point of commencement.

(i) the area within the following boundaries (which includes the towns of Fernvale, Plainland and Gatton):

Commencing from the point where the Warrego Highway intersects with the Brisbane Valley Highway; from that point following the Brisbane Valley Highway in a north westerly direction until the intersection with Forest Hill Fernvale Road; from that point following a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Wallers Road and Logan Road; from that point in a straight line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Gatton Helidon Road and Gatton Clifton Road; from that point in a straight line in an easterly direction to the intersection of Ipswich Rosewood Road and Cunningham Highway; and from that point in a straight line in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

(j) the town of Woodford being the area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Beerburrum-Woodford Road and Cemetery Road; from that point following a line in a westerly direction to the intersection of the D'Aguiar Highway with Old Cove Road; from that point in a southerly direction to the intersection of Kropp Road and Ironbark Drive; from that point in an easterly direction to the intersection of Mason Road and Chambers Road; from that point in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

Brisbane Statistical Division - The Brisbane Statistical Division defined in the 2001 edition of the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (Cat. No. 1216.0) published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics:

Provided that for the purposes of trading on Saturdays this definition excludes the islands as defined in clause (5) of Schedule 1⁴.

The Cairns CBD Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Alpin Street intersects with the Esplanade; from that point along the Esplanade to the intersection with Spence Street; from that point along Spence Street to the intersection of Bunda Street; from that point along Bunda Street to the intersection of Alpin Street; from that point along Alpin Street to the point of commencement.

The Great Barrier Reef Wonderland Tourist Complex

Shops which are an integral part of the Tourist Complex that are situated on a site bounded by Flinders Street East and the foreshores of the Ross Creek which are prepared to remain open 7 days a week to provide a service to tourists.

Townsville Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Morris Street and Flinders Street; thence along Flinders Street to Bridge Street; thence by Bridge Street to the railway line; thence by the railway line to its junction with Ross Creek; thence by the northern bank of that creek to a point in a direct line with the Strand; thence along the Strand to its junction with Howitt Street; thence along Howitt Street to its junction with Warburton Street; thence in a southerly direction along Warburton, Eyre, Oxley and Denham Streets to the junction of Denham Street and Wills Street; thence along Wills Street to its junction with Blackwood Street; thence along Blackwood Street to its junction with Walker Street; thence along Walker Street to its junction with Morris Street; thence along Morris Street to its junction with Flinders Street:

Provided that any premises facing onto any of the named streets shall be deemed to be within the defined area.

Note: The Townsville Tourist Area includes the area known as *The Townsville Central Business District* - The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Morris Street and Flinders Street; then along Flinders Street to Bridge Street; then by Bridge Street to the Railway Line; then by the Railway Line to its junction with Ross Creek; then by the Northern Bank of that creek to a point in a direct line with the Strand; then along the Strand to its junction with Melton Terrace; then along Melton Terrace to its junction with Denham Street; then along Denham Street to its junction with Wills Street; then along Wills Street to its junction with Blackwood Street; then along Blackwood Street to its junction with Walker Street; then along Walker Street to its junction with Morris Street; then along Morris Street to its junction with Flinders Street.

Cairns Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at a line due west from the sea coast to the junction of Jensen and Montrose Streets, then following a line in a north-west direction to the junction of Kamerunga Road and Brinsmead Road, then following Brinsmead Kamerunga Road in a westerly direction until its junction with Harley Street, then following Harley Street in a southerly direction until its join with Daphne Street, then following Daphne Street to its junction with Harvey Road, then following Harvey Road in a southerly direction to the junction of Harvey Road and Robb Road, then following a line due south to Hambleton Road (formerly Isabella Road), then following a line in a south-easterly direction to the junction of Mt Peter Road and Petersen Road, then following a line due east to the sea coast; and

Commencing from the township of Ellis Beach where it is located on the Captain Cook Highway, then following the Captain Cook Highway in a southerly direction to the point where the Captain Cook Highway crosses the Barron River, then following the Barron River in an easterly direction to the sea coast, then following the sea coast in a northerly direction to the point of commencement (viz. the township of Ellis Beach where it is located on the sea coast); and

Commencing from the junction of the Captain Cook Highway and Stanton Road, west along Stanton Road to the junction of Stanton Road and Upper Stanton Road, then a line due south to the Kennedy Highway, then east along the Kennedy Highway to the junction with the Captain Cook Highway, then north along the Captain Cook Highway to the point of commencement.

Whitsunday Shire Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Coconut and Shute Harbour Road. Then due east to the shoreline of Boat Haven proceeding along the foreshore in a northerly and then westerly direction to the mouth of Galbraith Creek. Then south along Galbraith Creek to the junction of Galbraith Creek and Shute Harbour Road. Then in a line of a north easterly direction to the eastern end of Tropic Road, then to the eastern most end of Eshelby Drive, then to the junction of Orana Street and Waterson Road. Then proceeding in a line back to the junction of Coconut Drive and Shute Harbour Road crossing the intersection of Harper Street and Golden Orchard Drive.

Fraser Coast Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where the Mary River meets the sea coast; then by a line in a south westerly direction to the intersection of the Bruce Highway and Four Mile Road; then by a line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Maryborough-Biggenden Road and Mungar Road; then in a line in a north easterly direction to the point where the Eli Creek meets the sea coast; then by the sea coast to the point of commencement.

Townsville and Thuringowa Area (excluding the Townsville Tourist Area)

The local authority areas of the cities of Townsville and Thuringowa excluding the Townsville Tourist Area as defined in subclause (9)⁵.

The Yeppoon Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Anzac Parade and John Street; then along John Street in a westerly direction to its junction with Park Street; then along Park Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Tanby and Rockhampton Roads; then along Rockhampton Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Birdwood Avenue; then in a straight line to the junction of Shadow Brook Place and Caroline Street; then following a straight line due east to Farnborough Road; then along Farnborough Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Anzac Parade; then along Anzac Parade to the point of commencement.

The Moranbah Area

The area within the following boundaries:

In the town of Moranbah, commencing at the corner of Sarchedon Drive and Goonyella Road; then in a straight line in a south easterly direction to the intersection of Mills Avenue and Rupert Street; then in a straight line in a south westerly direction to the intersection of Mills Avenue and Goonyella Road; then along Goonyella Road in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

The Cooloola Cove Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Woolworths Cooloola, 46 Queen Elizabeth Drive, Cooloola Cove QLD 4580, Lot 3 on SP 209132, Property Parcel 39668.

The City of Rockhampton Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Bruce Highway and Meldrum Road; then in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the intersection of the Capricorn Highway and Malchi Nine Mile Road; then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Gavial Gracemere Road and the Bruce Highway; then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of the Rockhampton Emu Park Road and Black Creek Road; then in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of the Rockhampton Yeppoon Road and Caporn Road; then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the point of commencement.

The City of Toowoomba Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of the New England Highway and Meringandan Road in Cabarlah; then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction until the intersection of Yalangur Lilyvale Road and Gowrie Lilyvale Road, then in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the junction of the Gore Highway and Muller Road; then in a straight line in an easterly direction to the intersection of the Nelson Street and Rowbotham Street; then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the junction of Prince Henry Drive and Jubilee Court; then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the point of commencement.

The Mackay Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the 21st parallel of south latitude with the 149th degree of east longitude; then by that meridian of east longitude due south to 21 degrees 40 minutes of south latitude; then by that parallel of latitude due east to the sea coast; then by the sea coast northerly to the point of commencement.

The Innisfail Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Taylor Street intersects with the Bruce Highway; from that point along Taylor Street in an easterly direction until it becomes Garradunga Road; from that point along Garradunga Road until it becomes Jubilee Road; from that point along Jubilee Road until it intersects with Flying Fish Point Road; from that point along Reynolds Road until it intersects with Bergin Road; from that point in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of River Road and Esplanade; from that point in a straight line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Louis Road and Rifle Range Road; from that point in a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Spannagle Road and the Palmerston Highway; from that point along the Palmerston Highway in a northerly direction to the intersection with the Bruce Highway; from that point along the Bruce Highway in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

The Emerald Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Holzwart Road intersects with the Capricorn Highway; from that point in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Donahue Road and Little Farm Road; from that point along Garradunga Road until it becomes Jubilee Road; from that point in a straight line in a north westerly direction to the intersection of Emerald Downs Road and the Gregory Highway; from that point in a straight line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Tyson Road and the Capricorn Highway; from that point in a straight line in a south easterly direction to the intersection of Rifle Range Road and Pilot Farm Road; from that point along Pilot Farm Road in a easterly direction to the intersection with the Gregory Highway; from that point in a straight line in a north easterly direction to the point of commencement.

The Tablelands Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Carrington Road intersects with Atherton Herberton Road; from that point in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Springs Road and Mareeba Dimbulah Road; from that point in a straight line in an easterly direction to the intersection of Gilmore Road and the Kennedy Highway/ Savannah Way; from that point in a straight line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Aerodrome Road and Gordonvale Atherton Road; from that point in a straight line in a westerly direction to the point of commencement.

The Gladstone Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where the Calliope River meets the coast line; from that point along the Calliope River until it intersects with the Bruce Highway; from that point along the Bruce Highway in a south easterly direction until the intersection with Silica Road; from that point in a straight line along Silica Road and beyond the termination of Silica Road in a northerly direction until the coast line; and then following the coast line in a north westerly direction to the point of commencement.

Bundaberg Area (which includes Elliott Heads, Bundaberg and Bargara)

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the point where the Burnett River meets the sea coast; then by a line in a south westerly direction to the intersection of Moorlands Road and Bundaberg-Gin Gin Road; then by a line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Bundaberg-Childers Road and Bundaberg Ring Road; then by a line in an easterly direction to the point where the Elliott River meets the sea coast; and then by the sea coast to the point of commencement.

The Gympie Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of Tin Can Bay Road with the Bruce Highway; then in a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Eel Creek Road and Regan Road; then in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of the Bruce Highway with Benson Road; then in a straight line in an easterly direction to the intersection of the Gympie Connection Road and Tin Can Bay Road; then in a straight line in a southerly direction to the point of commencement:

Provided that where the boundary is comprised of a street, road or highway, shops on both sides of the street, road or highway shall be regarded as being within the area.

The Biloela Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Callide Dam Road and Dawson Highway; then in a straight line due west to the point of intersection with the Burnett Highway; then in a straight line due south to the point of intersection with the Dawson Highway; then in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of the Burnett Highway and Van Itallies Road; then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of Linkes Road and Callide Dam Road; then along Callide Dam Road to the point of commencement:

Provided that where the boundary is comprised of a street, road or highway, shops on both sides of the street, road or highway shall be regarded as being within the area.

The Marian Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Mackay-Eungella Road and Boundary Road; then in a westerly direction to the intersections of Newmans, Mirabellas and Vickers Roads; then in a south-westerly direction to the intersection of Markeys Road and Mackay-Eungella Road; then in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Clares Road and Kennys Road; then along Kennys Road to the intersection of Newbury Mount Vince Road; then along Newberry Mount Vince Road and Boundary Road to the point of commencement:

Provided that where the boundary is comprised of a street, road or highway, shops on both sides of the street, road or highway shall be regarded as being within the area.

The Stanthorpe Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the New England Highway and Connor St; then by a line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Corundum St and Talc St; then by a line in a southerly direction to the intersection of Bridge St and Kilpa St; then by a line in an easterly direction to the intersection of Wolfram St and Anzac St; then by a line in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

The Warwick Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Cunningham Highway and Jackie Howe Dr; then by a line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Victoria St and Rosehill Rd; then by line in a southerly direction to the intersection of New England Hwy and Pratten St; then by a line in an easterly direction to the intersection of Pratten St and Pratten St East; then by a line in a northerly direction to the point of commencement.

Emu Park Tourist Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Connor Street intersects with Hartley Street; from that point in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Phillip Street and Yeppoon-Emu Park Road; from that point in an easterly direction until the sea coast; and then following the sea coast in a southerly direction until the eastern most end of Connor Street; then by a western direction to the point of commencement.

The Dalby Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where the Warrego Highway intersects with Blaxland South Road; from that point in a straight line in a northerly direction until the intersection of Ashmore Street and the Bunya Highway; from the point in a straight line in a westerly direction until the intersection of Dalby Kogan Road and the Warrego Highway; from that point in a straight line in a southerly direction until the intersection of Wilds Road and Andersons Road; and then in a straight line in an easterly direction to the point of commencement.

The Ingham Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the Bruce Highway and Hawkins Creek Road; then by a line in a south westerly direction to the intersection Ingham-Abergowrie Road and Hamleigh Road; then by a line in a south easterly direction to the intersection of the Bruce Highway and Tokalon Road; then by a line in a north easterly direction to the intersection of Victoria Mill Road and Four Mile Road; then by a line in a north westerly direction to the point of commencement.

Westfield Chermside shopping complex⁶

Means the shopping complex located at the corner of Gympie Road and Hamilton Road Chermside, Brisbane

Westfield Garden City shopping complex⁷

Means the shopping complex located on the corner of Logan Road and Kessels Road, Upper Mount Gravatt, Brisbane.

Sunshine Coast Area

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the far north point of Noosa Heads then following the coast line west, to the Noosa River, following the river to its junction with Wooroi Creek, then following Wooroi Creek to its junction with McKinnon Drive, then following that road east to its junction with Butler Street, then following Butler Street south west (the road becoming Cooroy-Noosa Road) until its junction with Beckhams Road, following that road to its junction with the Eumundi Noosa Road, then following that road to its junction with Fellowship Drive, then in a straight line south to Nambour-Bli Bli Road, then following that road west (the road becoming Bli Bli Road, National Park Road, Netherton Street, Blackall Terrace and Mapleton Road) to the junction of Mapleton Road and Carter Road, then following Carter Road to its junction with Arundell Avenue, then following Arundell Avenue to its junction with Lamington Terrace, then following Lamington Terrace in a south-easterly direction until it becomes the Nambour Connection Road,

then following the Nambour Connection Road in a southerly direction to its junction with the Bruce Highway, then following the Bruce Highway in a southerly direction to its junction with the Sunshine Motorway, then following the Sunshine Motorway east to its junction with Military Road, then in a straight line south to Bells Creek, then following that creek to the Pumicestone Channel; and

The suburb of Maleny.

The Woolloongabba Central Business District

The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Wellington Road and Stanley Street; then along Stanley Street to Annerley Road; then along Annerley Road to Catherine Street; then along Catherine Street to Merton Street; then along Merton Street to Hawthorne Street; then along Hawthorne Street to Ipswich Road; then along Ipswich Road to Balaclava Street; then along Balaclava Street to Wellington Road; then along Wellington Road to its junction with Stanley Street:

Provided that any premises facing onto any of the named streets shall be deemed to be within the defined area.

The Rockhampton Central Business District

The area bounded by the Fitzroy River, North Street, George Street and Stanley Street.

The Gold Coast Area

That part of the eastern portion of the State within the following boundaries:- Commencing at the junction of the sea coast and the southern bank of the Coomera River thence along the southern bank of that river to its junction with Coombabah Creek; thence by the southern bank of that creek to the Gold Coast Highway; thence westerly along the Gold Coast Highway to its junction with the Pacific Highway; thence by a straight line to the point on the Nerang River situated one kilometre in a direct line westerly from the nearest point on the western boundary of the Pacific Highway; thence by a line parallel to, and one kilometre to the west of, the western boundary of the Pacific Highway to the intersection of that line with the Tallebudgera Creek Road; thence by a straight line to a point on the Queensland-New South Wales border situated six kilometres in a direct line from the sea coast at its nearest point; thence by that border to its junction with the sea coast; thence by the sea coast to the point of commencement.

Redcliffe Peninsula

shall mean and include the local authority area of the City of Redcliffe (which includes Clontarf, Woody Point, Margate, Kippa Ring and Scarborough).

City of Brisbane Area

shall mean and include the local authority area of the "City of Brisbane" as defined by the *City of Brisbane Act 1924-1982*.

City of Logan Area

shall mean and include the local authority area defined as the Shire of Logan by the *"Local Government (Adjustment of Boundaries) Act 1978"*.

Town of Beenleigh Area

shall mean the area enclosed by a line commencing at the point at which the Pacific Highway crosses the Albert River (approximately 2 1/4 kilometres south-west of the Beenleigh Post Office) and thence by following the Albert River in a northerly direction to the point where it intersects the Logan River; and thence by following the Logan River in a westerly direction to the point where Albert Street crosses the Logan River; and thence along Albert Street, Beenleigh Road and Logan River Road to the point where Teys Road intersects Logan River Road; and thence along Teys Road, Prangley Road and Bahrs Scrub Road to the point where Bahrs Scrub Road intersects Beenleigh-Beaudesert Road; and thence by a straight line extended from Bahrs Scrub Road, in the same direction as Bahrs Scrub Road, to the point where that line intersects the Albert River; and thence along the Albert River back to the starting point.

Near North Coast Area

The area containing those portions of the Shires of Noosa, Maroochy, Landsborough and Caboolture east of 152.55 degrees east longitude.

Shire of Pine Rivers Area

shall mean and include the Local Authority area of the Shire of Pine Rivers area as defined by the *"Local Government (Adjustment of Boundaries) Act 1978"*, as amended.

Redland Shire Area

shall mean and include the Local Authority area of the Redland Shire as defined by the *"Local Government (Adjustment of Boundaries) Act 1978"*, as amended.

City of Ipswich

shall mean the area shown on Department of Natural Resources Map, titled Plan of City of Ipswich LGB66 Edition 2.
