## **CEMENT INDUSTRY AWARD - STATE 2003**

#### (Gazette, 11 April 2003)

PURSUANT to the Declaration of the Commission as to a General Ruling made on 21 August 2009, the said Award is amended as follows as from 1 September 2009:

# 1. <u>By deleting the preamble and classification rates in subclause (1) of Schedule 1 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:</u>

This Schedule shall not apply to Queensland Cement Limited or Central Queensland Cement Pty Ltd during the trial period of Schedule 3 commencing on 3 March 1993.
