DECISION

BRISBANE TRUCK SHOW

- [1] An application has been made by The Commercial Vehicle Industry Association of Queensland (CVIAQ), to the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission under the *Trading (Allowable Hours) Act 1990* (Act), for an amendment of the trading hours fixed by the order, *Trading Hours - Non-Exempt Shops Trading By Retail - State* (Order), as follows:

"By deleting the title and first subclause of clause 22 from Schedule 2 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

22.

TRADING HOURS - BRISBANE TRUCK SHOW

ORDER

- (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other Order to the contrary, this Order shall apply to exhibitors of the special exhibition known as the Brisbane Truck Show to be held at the premises of Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre, Corner of Merivale & Glenelg Streets, Southbank, Queensland for four consecutive days from Thursday to Sunday in the month of May, every second year, commencing in 2011."
- [2] The CVIAQ is the peak body representing manufacturers and suppliers of commercial vehicles and their components and is bound by the Order.
- [3] CVIAQ have conducted the Queensland Truck and Machinery Show from the premises of the Royal National Association, Gregory Terrace, Brisbane for four consecutive days from Thursday to Sunday in the month of May, every second year, commencing in 1999.
- [4] CVIAQ wishes to amend the title from the "Queensland Truck and Machinery Show" to the "Brisbane Truck Show" and to conduct the "Brisbane Truck Show" from the premises of the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre, Corner of Merivale and Glenelg Streets, Southbank, Queensland during the hours provided for by the Order.
- [5] In accordance with s. 22 of the Act, the Full Bench grants the application sought.
- [6] Order accordingly.
