(e) **Payment of salaries**

Salaries shall be paid fortnightly and may at the discretion of the chief executive officer be paid by electronic funds transfer.

- 2. By deleting clause 18.5(a) and inserting the following in lieu thereof:
 - (a) Where an employee is instructed by the chief executive officer or a duly authorised employee to be available on call outside their ordinary or rostered working hours for duty, the employee is to be paid, in addition to the ordinary rate of pay, an allowance in accordance with the following scale:
 - (i) where the employee is on call throughout the whole of a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday: \$18.00 in respect of such instances;
 - (ii) where an employee is on call during the night only of a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday: \$11.60 per night; and
 - (iii) where an employee is on call on any other night: \$9.20 per night.
