Salaries shall be paid fortnightly and may at the discretion of a chief executive be paid by electronic funds transfer.

(h) Savings provision

Employees of the undermentioned agencies who are in receipt of a higher rate of salary, as at the date of commencement of this Award, than prescribed for the equivalent classification in clauses 12.1(a) to

(d), inclusive, and (f) shall not suffer a reduction in salary because of their transfer to coverage under this Award:

- (i) Crime and Corruption Commission;
- (ii) Queensland Building and Construction Commission;
- (iii) QRAA;
- (iv) Residential Tenancies Authority; and
- (v) Safe Food Queensland.
- 2. By deleting clause S1.4.2 "Salary levels" in Schedule 1.
- 3. By renumbering clause S1.4.3 "Principles for progression" as clause S1.4.2.
